Details:	Per inter-department intelligence report, rapper Keith Cozart, (a.k.a Chief Keef, is a documented member of the Black Disciples out of Chicago, IL. He has an extensive violent criminal history and has openly engaged in threats of violence, on social media, with local rival gangs. Intelligence reports suggest the likelihood of violence to erupt at this concert.

Action Summary: The Neighborhood Enforcement Team and Police Canine Unit will provide roving patrols upon the parking lot of the concert venue and adjacent businesses prior to the end of the performance. Uniformed officers working secondary at the concert venue will be stationed at all entry/exit points and assist with crowd control. Platoon officers will be stationed at fixed points for traffic control.		
Objective: The objective of this operation is to safely perform the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Prevent any crimes against persons or property from occurring during the enforcement.Prevent traffic congestion or vehicle accidents at the conclusion of the event.Assure the patrons of this event and adjacent property owners that their safety is a priority.		
Traffic Control Posts: 1:00am (Anticipated time of disbursement) In an effort to evacuate the parking lot in a safe and timely manner, all vehicle traffic leaving the venue parking lot will be directed to southbound Lucas Hunt. Officers will be assigned to the following intersections: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Parking lot exit onto northbound Halls FerryHalls Ferry @ Lucas Hunt (diverting all northbound traffic onto Lucas Hunt)Lucas Hunt @ Nemnich (preventing right turn onto Nemnich)Lucas Hunt @ Jacobi (preventing right turn onto Jacobi and/or u-turns back to Halls Ferry)Lucas Hunt @ Hord (diverting northbound traffic from going to Halls Ferry)

Command and Control: Sergeant Law will be the on-duty supervisor with primary responsibility of this operation and will insure that each person involved in the operation has a clear understanding of their assignment and responsibilities.
