INTERVIEW NOTIFICATION

I wish to advise you that you are being questioned as part of an official investigation of the St. Louis County Police Department. You will be asked questions specifically directed and narrowly related to the performance of your official duties or fitness for office. You are entitled to all the rights and privileges guaranteed by the laws and the constitution of this State, including the right not to be compelled to incriminate yourself. I further wish to advise you that if you refuse to testify or to answer questions relating to the performance of your duties or fitness for duty, you will be subject to Departmental charges, which could result in your dismissal from the St. Louis County Police Department. If you do answer truthfully, neither your statements nor any information or evidence, which is gained by reason of such statements, can be used against you in any subsequent criminal proceedings however, these statements may be used against you in relation to subsequent Department charges. *If you do not answer truthfully, any false statements you make may subject you to future prosecution for crimes including, but not limited to, perjury and/or obstruction of justice.*
